



Not yet formalized, but our ambitions are set:

Ownership Of any user data [passwords,emails...] remains with the user.

Control Maximum control for the user.

Active data Delete a mail and it's gone, both from TMail and the Parliament servers.

Backups Incremental backups means all data is retained. Can be deleted or handed over on user request.

Cancellation If at any point a user cancels their account, all data belonging to that user will be deleted.
